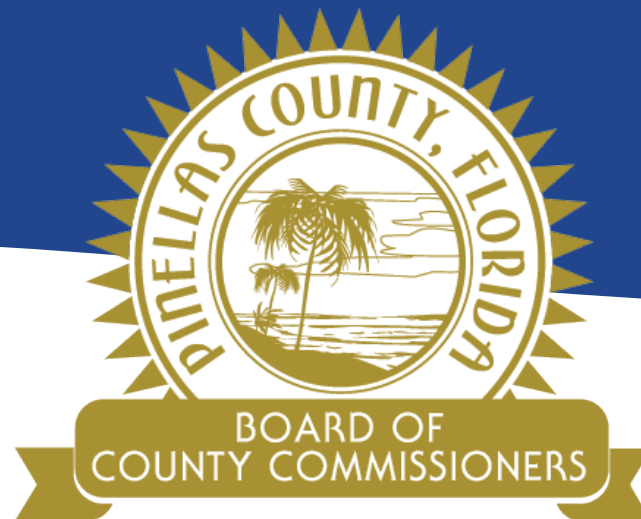

Reasons why the moratorium is needed

- **Grants staff time to review this complex issue**
- **Data collection at county, state and federal level**

Moratorium Restrictions

- Prohibits approval of new permits
- Prohibits revisions to existing permits



Chapter 14-29 Ordinance Moratorium

Moratorium Length

- **A one-year time period for the moratorium**
- **The moratorium may be shortened prior to one year with the adoption of regulations pertaining to the retail sale of pets in the County**

Moratorium Goals

- **Animal welfare protections**
- **Strengthen consumer protections**
