- Adoption Requirements
 - Section 163.3177(6)(c), Florida Statutes (F.S.)
 - Within 18 months after the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) adopts, or updates, the Regional Water Supply Plan
 - The most recently updated Regional Water Supply Plan was approved by SWFWMD in November 2020



- State Agency Review and Comments
 - Six agencies commented on the Ordinance
 - Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO)
 - Department of Transportation (FDOT)
 - Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC)
 - Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs
 - Florida Department of Environmental Projection (FDEP)
 - Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD)***
