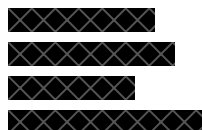

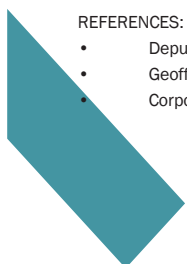

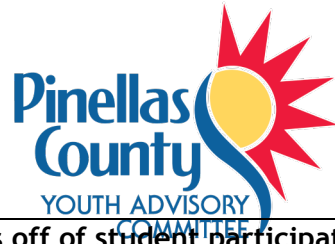

My leadership skills, county government experience, STEM knowledge and strict discipline aid my efforts to help others, find justice, and create change.

SERVICE

- November 2017 – Present – I am the co-founder and coordinator of BatsFlips4Kids, a nonprofit established in 2017. We are dedicated to providing sports equipment to youth in need. We collect bats and used baseball equipment at Pinellas and Hillsborough County Little Leagues as well as youth sports clinics. We ship and provide delivery of donations to players in areas such as Central Florida, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico and Kenya. I coordinate with the Tampa Bay Rays and First United Methodist Church to fund shipments. Since 2017, we have collected over 400 bats: 60 sent to Central Florida, 100 sent to Dominican Republic, 40 to Kenya and approximately 150 additional donated bats in process for Cuba delivery in April 2021. In January 2022, we delivered 5 L-screens donated by Clearwater Central Catholic High School to a little league in St. Petersburg.
- January 2022 – Present – Founder of Books Behind Bats – a program designed to encourage academic success for young athletes. The program collects new and used books and school supplies for Pinellas County youth who attend athletic programs for underprivileged youth such as Stars of the Future sponsored by the Pete Mulry Foundation.
- September 2020 - Present - Contributed in excess of 102 student volunteer hours to date since starting high school in Sept 2020. I have worked as, a volunteer umpire for Little League, volunteer coach for Northeast Little League 11u baseball, volunteered for baseball equipment collections and serve as a Clearwater Central Catholic School Ambassador.
