DBA Directions for Living</b>	Telehealth Remote Access to Crisis Evaluation (TRACE)	\$57,500.00	Crisis Counselors for TRACE is a behavioral health program developed by DFL that provides virtual crisis intervention to divert persons from entering the wrong system (i.e., jail, crisis stabilization units) and works with police departments.
<b>MORE Health, Inc.</b>	Firearm Safety and Violence Prevention Project	\$25,000.00	Funding to provide Firearm Safety Education Lessons to children, teens, their families, and their teachers. All of Pinellas County's public third-grade classes are offered this safety lesson.
<b>Suncoast Center, Inc.</b>	Forensic Focused Outreach Services	\$40,000.00	Funding to provide psychiatric evaluations, mental health and substance abuse symptom management; treatment planning, screenings, counseling, therapy, and case management to clients.
<b>Tarpons Springs (Police Department)</b>	Traffic accident scanner	\$40,873.00	Traffic accident scene scanner
<b>WestCare</b>	Mustard Seed Inn Case Management	\$50,000.00	Funding to support a Recovery Support Specialist/Case Manager to assist adults with substance abuse and/or co-occurring mental health disorders to stay substance free, learn how to cope with crisis, learn how to stay safe, obtain employment, and connect them to other services as needed.
