## **Description & Comments**

This is an amendment to the contract with EmCare, Inc. which provides for all medical direction services for the Pinellas County EMS system, as well as online medical control on a twenty-four (24) hours a day / seven (7) days a week basis. Services under this contract also include management and operation of Online Medical Control (OMC) by physicians, protocol and policy review, clinical leadership and oversight of the Pinellas County EMS, oversight of re-certification of all system personnel, review and approval of medical supply and equipment standards, review and approval of all training materials and curriculum produced and delivered by the Continuing Medical Education (CME) Program, emergency field response and scene observation to meet State EMS requirements.

This amendment is to recognize the Pinellas County Sheriff Tactical EMS Team as an approved Pinellas County First Responder under the clinical oversight of the EMS Medical Director.

This amendment has no fiscal or budgetary impact to the County.
