#4 Ordinance No. 06-12 adopted providing for authority for the use of golf carts, with conditions, west of Alternate U.S. Highway 19 for the areas of Ozona and Crystal Beach. Staff recommended approval of the proposed ordinance. No correspondence has been received. Director of Transportation Peter Yauch presented a brief summary of the provisions of the proposed ordinance. Comments by JoAn Totty, Palm Harbor, in objection to the proposed ordinance were noted.

Alluding to the concerns of the objector, Commissioner Latvala and Planning Director Brian K. Smith indicated that homeowners' insurance policies would provide coverage regarding the golf carts. Responding to query by the Chairman, Mr. Yauch confirmed that golf cart usage will be permissible 24 hours a day; and that the Sheriff's Department has not changed its position in opposition to the ordinance. In reply to query by Commissioner Stewart, Attorney Churuti stated that the ordinance would allow the Sheriff's Office to write tickets; and Mr. Spratt indicated that the issue of seat belts had been changed upon determination that the seat belts were not as safe as the use of hip restraints.

WHEREAS, the Board has received requests from representatives of the communities of Ozona and Crystal Beach to permit the use of golf carts on community streets in those areas; and

Golf carts equipped in the manner prescribed by this Ordinance may travel on or cross the public roads or streets within the geographic boundaries described in this Ordinance, considering factors including the speed, volume, and character of motor vehicle traffic using these roads or streets, and the use of golf carts is hereby permitted in the Ozona and Crystal Beach Communities with the stipulations to include the following provisions:

- (a) Required equipment for a golf cart shall include headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, tail lamps, reflex reflectors, parking brakes, a rearview mirror, a windshield and a standard hip restraint or hand hold.
  - (b) The golf cart operators must possess a valid driver's license pursuant to Fla. Stats. sec. 322.03.
- (c) The areas encompassed by this authorization are the community areas of Ozona and Crystal Beach located west of U.S. Alternate 19, north of Orange Street and south of Ulelah Avenue. For the purpose of this Ordinance the southern boundary of Ozona is the intersection of Orange Street and U.S. Alternate 19, and the northern boundary of Crystal Beach is Ulelah Avenue and U.S. Alternate 19. Golf carts shall not be operated within the right-of-way of U.S. Alternate 19.
  - (d) The golf carts authorized for use are incapable of exceeding 20 miles per hour.
- (e) Golf carts may be operated during the hours between sunset and sunrise as well as during daylight hours in the designated areas only.

#### Section 2. Penalties.

A violation of subsection (a) of this ordinance is a noncriminal violation pursuant to Fla. Stats. sec. 316.212(7) punishable as a nonmoving violation.

A violation of subsection (c) of this ordinance is a noncriminal violation pursuant to Fla. Stats. sec. 316.212(7) punishable as a moving violation.

## Section 3. Territory Embraced.

This Ordinance shall apply only to the designated unincorporated area of the County.

## Section 4. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance, or the particular application thereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, administrative agency, or other body with appropriate jurisdiction, the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases and their application shall not be affected thereby.

## Section 5. Codification.

This ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Pinellas County Code, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately numbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Pinellas County Code.

## Section 6. Filing of Ordinance; Effective Date.

Pursuant to Section 125.66 Fla. Stats.-(2004), a certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners within ten (10) days after enactment by the Board of County Commissioners. This ordinance shall become effective upon filing of the ordinance with the Department of State.
