## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PINELLAS COUNTY CODE

The Pinellas County (the "County") Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") proposes to amend the Pinellas County Code by Ordinance (the "Ordinance"). The Ordinance is titled as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF PINELLAS, PROVIDING THAT THE PINELLAS COUNTY CODE BE AMENDED BY REVISING CHAPTER 122, ARTICLE IV RELATING TO GOLF CARTS; REVISING SECTION 122-67 RELATING TO GOLF CART USE UPON CERTAIN ROADWAYS IN OZONA AND CRYSTAL BEACH TO ALLOW FOR THE INCLUSION OF ROADWAYS IN ADDITIONAL COMMUNITIES AND TO **IMPOSE** RESTRICTIONS CONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW; REVISING SECTION 122-68 RELATING TO GOLF CART USE UPON CERTAIN ROADWAYS IN HIGHLAND LAKES TO ALLOW FOR THE INCLUSION OF ROADWAYS IN ADDITIONAL **COMMUNITIES** AND TO **IMPOSE** RESTRICTIONS CONSISTENT WITH STATE LAW: CREATING SECTION 122-69 PROVIDING FOR DESIGNATION OF ROADWAYS FOR GOLF CART USE BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION: CREATING SECTION 122-70 CLARIFYING THAT THIS ARTICLE DOES NOT APPLY TO LOW-SPEED VEHICLES: CREATING SECTION 122-71 CLARIFYING THAT THIS ARTICLE DOES NOT APPLY TO INCORPORATED AREAS: CREATING APPENDIX F AND APPENDIX G OF THE CODE IDENTIFYING ROADWAYS WHERE GOLF CART USE IS PERMITTED; **PROVIDING** FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE COUNTY CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Board will hold a public hearing (the "Hearing") on the Ordinance on **Thursday September 10, 2020,** at **6:00 P.M.**, at the County Parks and Conservation Resources Department's Magnolia Room, 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo, Florida 33774. The Hearing is a hybrid in-person and virtual public hearing due to current Declaration of Emergency relating to the COVID-19 pandemic and CDC recommended social distancing guidelines. The Hearing will be broadcast live at <a href="https://youtube.com/pcctv1">https://youtube.com/pcctv1</a> and on the following County cable public access channels: Spectrum Channel 637, Frontier Channel 44 WOW!, Channel 18.

Members of the public may address the Board on the Ordinance in person during the Hearing. However, space for in-person attendance is very limited due to COVID-19 social distancing so the public is strongly encouraged to participate virtually.
