

RESOLUTION NO. 10- 198

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION No. 08-57; DESIGNATING COUNTY CODE ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL TO ENFORCE COUNTY CODES AND REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 125, CHAPTER 162, AND CHAPTER 705 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC RECORDS EXEMPTIONS FOR CURRENT AND FORMER CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, authorizes counties in the State of Florida to impose fines or imprisonment for violations of ordinances and to provide for enforcement of its ordinances by code inspectors; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, permits designated code inspectors to request hearings and ensure code compliance pursuant to said chapter; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 705, Florida Statutes, authorizes counties to designate employees who have the authority to enforce codes or ordinances to administer the provisions of said chapter; and

WHEREAS, Section 119.071(4)(d)1.g, Florida Statutes, provides additional public records exemptions for personal information of current and former code enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, previously designated certain agents or employees of the County as code inspectors with authority to issue citations for violations of County ordinances when such officer has knowledge that a violation has been committed via Resolution No. 08-57; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that, over time, the various positions designated as code inspectors have been re-classified or moved among various County departments such that it may be unclear what positions are authorized to act as code inspectors.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, in a regular session duly assembled this 21 day of September 2010, that:

Section 1. This Resolution is hereby superseded and replaces Resolution No. 08-57.

Section 2. The agents or employees of the County identified in Exhibit A attached hereto are hereby designated as code inspectors with authority to issue citations for violations of County ordinances in accordance with the provisions of Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, as amended; are hereby designated as code inspectors as defined in Section 162.04, Florida Statutes, as amended; are hereby authorized to administer the provisions of Chapter 705, Florida Statutes, as amended; and are hereby designated as code enforcement officers for purposes of Section 119.071, Florida Statutes, as amended:

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


Commissioner Morrone offered the foregoing Resolution and moved its adoption, which was seconded by Commissioner Harris, and upon roll call the vote was:
