




2022 Hurricane Season

- Analysis of flooding by properties and surge risk by storm







- Continuing to work with schools
- Preserve and add space

Sheltering

- Level E Evacuation
 Need approx. 59,000 spaces
- 24 locations at 10 sq. ft. per person 64,554 spaces

17 hours	Zone A and mobile homes
20 hours	Zone B, Zone A and mobile homes
26 hours	Zone C, Zone B, Zone A and mobile homes
42 hours	Zone D, Zone C, Zone B, Zone A and mobile homes
50 hours	Zone E, Zone D, Zone C, Zone B, Zone A and mobile homes


