The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to amend the Pinellas County Code by Ordinance.

A public hearing on the Ordinance will be held on Tuesday. April 23, 2024, at 6:00 P.M. in the Pinellas County Communications - Palm Room, 333 Chestnut Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756.

Interested parties may appear at the hearing and be heard regarding the proposed Ordinance.

## 1. PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PINELLAS **COUNTY CODE:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF PINELLAS, PROVIDING THAT THE PINELLAS COUNTY CODE BE AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO BE NUMBERED CHAPTER 110, ARTICLE III; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LOCAL PROVIDER PARTICIPATION FUND; PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF NON-AD **VALOREM** SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO BE IMPOSED, LEVIED, COLLECTED, AND ENFORCED AGAINST REAL PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY PRIVATE FOR-PROFIT AND NOT-FOR-PROFIT HOSPITALS TO FUND THE NON-FEDERAL SHARE OF MEDICAID PAYMENTS HOSPITALS BENEFITING **PROVIDING** SERVICES TO MEDICAID, HEALTHCARE INDIGENT, AND UNINSURED MEMBERS OF THE PINELLAS COUNTY COMMUNITY; PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE FOR ADOPTING THE ANNUAL NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE LOCAL PROVIDER PARTICIPATION FUND: PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZED USES FOR LOCAL PROVIDER PARTICIPATION **FUND** PROCEEDS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AREAS EMBRACED; PROVIDING FOR RESOLUTION OF CONFLICT OF LAWS; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
