**SUBJECT:** ARPA Nonprofit Capital Project Fund Applications

**DATE:** October 7, 2022

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Please find attached the following two lists provided by the Pinellas Community Foundation (PCF):

1. A summary of the 79 large capital projects Letters of Intent (LOIs) totaling \$83,636,947.70, submitted by Pinellas County nonprofit organizations.
2. A summary of the 80 small capital purchase applications totaling \$6,512,064.28, submitted by Pinellas County nonprofit organizations.

#### Background

The deadline for applications for both large project LOIs and small purchases was September 8, 2022. A total of \$17,967,000 is available for both the large and small projects.

As discussed at the July 28 Work Session with the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), the following allocations have been made:

- \$10,000,000 for large capital projects (again, \$83,636,947.70 of requests have been submitted),
- \$3,750,000 for small capital purchases (again, \$6,512,064.28 of requests have been submitted), and,
- the remaining \$4,217,000 is being held back to apportion after applications are ranked and reviewed to potentially be allocated to these amounts or to another round of small projects in the Spring.

As was also discussed at the July 28 Work Session, the PCF created a separate track for small nonprofit organizations with operating budgets less than \$500,000 to apply for small capital purchases to ensure they are given a fair chance to receive funding for their capital needs (within the \$3,750,000 allocation).

All rank and review meetings will be held in a transparent manner, open for observation by any interested party.

#### Next Steps - Small Capital Purchases

The rank and review of the small capital purchases is separated into two sessions:

- The small organizations will have their applications reviewed on October 24, 2022.
- The large and medium-sized organizations will have their applications reviewed on October 25, 2022.

The recommendation for approval of small capital purchases is expected to go before the Board on November 15, 2022.

The second round of small capital purchase applications is scheduled to open on January 9, 2023, and close on February 9, 2023.

Rank and review of the second round of small capital purchase applications is expected to take place in mid-March 2023.

Recommendations for approval to the Board for the second round of small applications is expected to take place in mid-April 2023, depending on the date of the rank and review meeting.

#### Next Steps - Large Capital Projects

The rank and review of the large capital project LOIs took place on October 6, 2022. Notifications will go out to all applicants on October 12, 2022. A list of projects approved to move to the full application phase will be posted on the PCF website.

Applications for the large capital projects was originally scheduled to be due in early November, 30 days after the nonprofit organization received the LOI decision from the PCF. However, the applicant nonprofit organizations have expressed a need for more time to assemble bids and other documents necessary to complete the application to standards required by the Department of the Treasury. A contract amendment with the PCF has been executed to add 30 days to accommodate the request, which will result in final large capital project applications being due to PCF on December 9, 2022.

Rank and review of the applications is expected to be completed on January 25, 2023. Given the revised timeline, recommendations for approval are expected to be presented to the Board on February 14.
