<p><b>Summary</b>            This agreement allows Raytheon Company to obtain a yearly Building permit to do construction in buildings at 7887 Bryan Dairy Road, #1444, Largo, FL 33777 without the requirement of scheduled routine in-progress inspections. The Building Department may still perform final inspections upon project completion and Raytheon agrees to hold the County harmless for construction activities conducted during the permit period.</p> <p><b>Fiscal Impact</b>            This has no fiscal impact on Pinellas County because the annual facility permit is an existing permit type available to any commercial property owner. Raytheon selecting this permit option does not create new costs and does not reduce expected revenues. The fees associated with the annual permit are already part of the Building Services Department’s user fee schedule.</p>
