**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY

VACATING THAT PORTION OF A 10 FOOT WIDE  
DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT LYING IN THE  
WEST 7 FEET OF THE EAST 10 FEET OF LOT 48, LESS  
THE SOUTH 5 FEET THEREOF, IMPERIAL POINT  
UNIT 1, PLAT BOOK 63, PAGE 86, LYING IN SECTION  
18-30-15, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING  
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** Thomas A. March (the Petitioner) has petitioned this Board of County Commissioners to vacate the following described property:

**WHEREAS,** the Petitioner has shown that he is the fee simple owner of the property covered by the portion of the plat sought to be vacated and that all taxes on said property have been paid; and

**WHEREAS,** the Petitioner has shown that the vacation of such portions of the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision; and

**WHEREAS,** the Petitioner's affidavit, has been received by the Board of County Commissioners.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida that the above described property and plat be hereby vacated, insofar as this Board of County Commissioners has the authority to do so, pursuant to Chapter 177, Florida Statutes.

**NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Board of County Commissioners shall adopt this resolution with authorization for the Clerk to record in the Public Records of Pinellas County, Florida.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption as provided by law.




