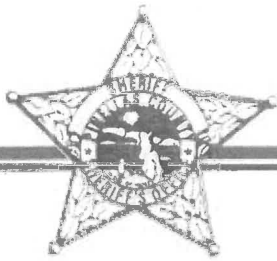



Enclosed is our check in the amount of \$1,029,891 which represents excess revenues over expenditures for Fiscal Year 2018-2019.


