Approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Purchase Authorization with Transportation Control Systems, Inc. for Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) approved Opticom Traffic Equipment, Pedestrian Push Buttons and Traffic Equipment Mounting Astro Brackets.

This purchase authorization provides a mechanism for the Public Works Department to purchase traffic equipment to support operational needs.

The initial purchase authorization was approved by the County Administrator on June 5, 2023, in the amount of \$318,720.00 with Econolite Control Products, Inc. (Econolite).

On July 25, 2023, the County Administrator approved the second purchase authorization adding Temple Inc. (Temple) as an additional vendor to the contract in the amount of \$161,352.00.

This addition adds Transportation Control Systems, Inc. (TCS) as an additional vendor to the contract in the amount of \$139,668.00, effective through March 13, 2024. By Code, the County Administrator may approve State of Florida Contract purchase authorizations in any amount.

This is a multi-vendor purchase authorization. Additional contractors may be requested to be added to this purchase authorization in the future, depending on need. Contract 23-0733-S increases in the amount of \$139,668.00 with TCS for a revised total contract of \$619,740.00, effective through March 2024.

The agreement is consistent with the FY24 Tentative Budget Development, and it is budgeted within the Transportation Trust Fund, Transportation Division of Public Works Department.
