Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

Elite Event funding was previously increased from \$750,000 to the current amount of \$2 million on October 26, 2010. Since that time, the Elite Event Funding Program has grown from five events to 39 events that were approved for funding in Fiscal Year 2025. If adopted, the proposed ordinance will increase the maximum annual funding for Elite Events to \$3 million. While this amendment to the plan would increase the cap, it doesn't increase the budgetary spending authority therefore, if CVB would like to increase the amount available to spend for the FY26 Elite Funding Cycle that request would need to be approved by the Board in the FY26 budget process.

In addition to the increase of the Elite Events cap, this amendment would also:

- Remove obsolete language related to prior payment obligations.
- Remove "recreation facilities," which is not an allowable use under Florida Statutes.
- Add "public facilities" associated with tourist attractions as an allowable use under Category D.
