PINELLAS COUNTY HEALTH PROGRAM INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT First Option of Renewal

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into on the date below, by and between PINELLAS COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY", and FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, an agency of the state of Florida providing public health services in Pinellas County, herein after referred to as the "PROVIDER".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires to continue to increase access to health care for the low-income uninsured residents of Pinellas County through the Pinellas County Health Program (PCHP) and the Mobile Medical Unit (MMU); and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the COUNTY to increase access to quality healthcare, improve the health outcomes of low-income/high risk individuals, and reduce health disparities in Pinellas County; and

WHEREAS, PROVIDER desires to continue working with the COUNTY to provide health care services to adult (18-64 years) uninsured residents of Pinellas County; and

WHEREAS, PROVIDER will work with key stakeholders from multiple agencies in Pinellas County to provide these primary health care services; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY desires that the PROVIDER provide for quality assurance, behavioral health, prescription assistance, specialty services and dental services in order to promote overall integrated health services for eligible clients; and

WHEREAS, PROVIDER is a strategic partner with the COUNTY and participates in the planning and implementation of effective cost containment and health quality measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

- This Agreement is hereby renewed pursuant to Section two (2) thereof, effective October
 1, 2016, continuing for a period of twelve months from that date unless terminated or cancelled as provided therein.
- 2. Except as herein provided, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

Approve the First Option of Renewal of the Interlocal Agreement with the Florida Department of Health (DOH Pinellas) for the Pinellas County Health Program (PCHP).

Summary:

This Agreement allows DOH Pinellas to continue to provide primary care, preventive health, behavioral health, dental services, prescription assistance and specialty care services, for uninsured adults' ages 18-64 who are in need of healthcare, but meet certain income level criteria and cannot afford care on their own. DOH Pinellas operates six medical homes, the Bayside Clinic, and the MMU to provide over 8,400 PCHP and Healthcare for the Homeless (HCH) clients with access to quality health care, improved health outcomes, and reduced health disparities with quality assurance.

Background Information:

DOH Pinellas has been a medical primary care provider for the PCHP since its inception in 2008. In FY2016 (FY16), care coordination was implemented through the DOH Pinellas agreement to aid in engaging clients in their health care. As of June 30, 2016, DOH Pinellas provided primary care services to 7,563 unique clients and dental services to 1,977 unique clients under the FY16 agreement.

On July 19, 2016, DOH received the Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) recognition from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA). The PCMH is a promising model for transforming an organization and the delivery of high-quality, accessible, efficient health care. A goal of the PCHP/HCH program is to prevent, diagnose, and/or treat medical and behavioral health concerns before they become an urgent matter.

As part of Human Services' ongoing partnership with DOH Pinellas, quarterly hospital coordination meetings have been held to work on discharge planning for clients. In addition, coordination

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meetings have been held with the Pinellas County Jail (PCJ) and Personal Enrichment for Mental Health Services (PEMHS) to explore opportunities to stabilize and reengage clients. These meetings are ongoing and will continue in FY17.

Under several new grant initiatives awarded to Human Services, DOH Pinellas is working to engage clients in expanded mental health services and medication assisted treatment opportunities. These efforts will continue in FY17.

Fiscal Impact:

Funding in an amount not to exceed \$11,540,788.00 has been identified in the Human Services' anticipated appropriation for FY17.
