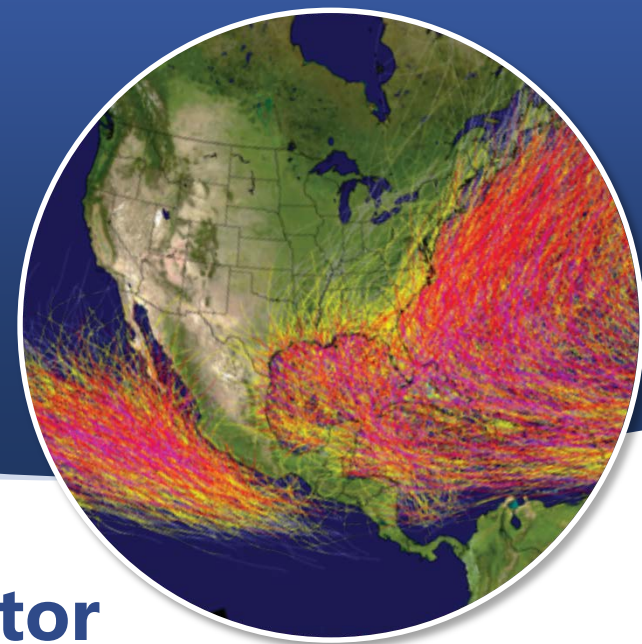

# Know Your Risk

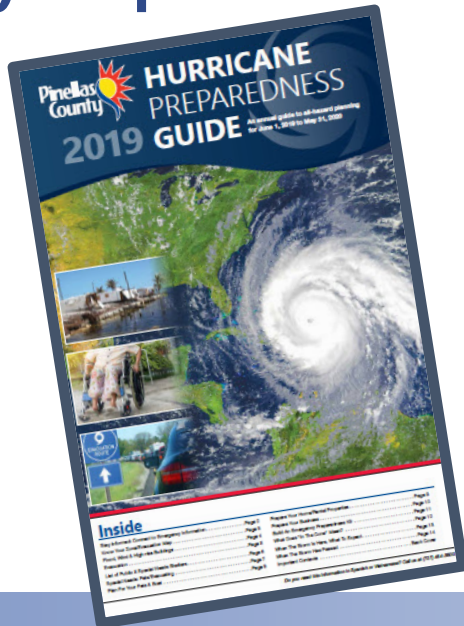
- Are you at risk for storm surge?

- Are you at risk for flooding?

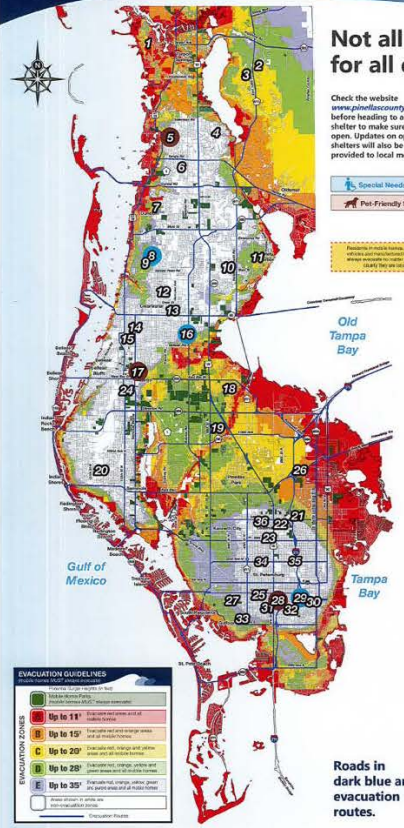
