Description & Comments

This is to conduct a public hearing to adopt the proposed ordinance to update the Pinellas County Code Chapter 58 (Environment), Article XVI (Mangrove Trimming and Preservation). Amendments include:

- Shifting appeals of staff determinations of mangrove trimming permits from the Board of County Commissioners to a special magistrate and updating related notice requirements.
- Providing additional enforcement mechanisms.
- Administrative updates to Chapter 58 (Environment), Article XVI (Mangrove Trimming and Preservation) Pinellas County Code to maintain consistency with Sections 403.9321 through 403.9333, Florida Statutes.
- Providing for posting of mangrove permits in close proximity to the project for duration of work to stay consistent with other permits issued by Water and Navigation.

This item has no fiscal impact on Pinellas County. Applicable fees for variances or appeals remain consistent regardless of whether the matter is heard by the Board of Adjustments (BOA), the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), or a Special Magistrate.
