1. Release all remaining retainage.

REASON FOR CHANGE:

Final inspections have been conducted for all Work performed under the contract terms by the representative of the Pinellas County Construction Management Division, Capital Improvement Division, Transportation Division, Stormwater Operations, EOR and FDOT. Substantial completion for this Project was achieved on March 10, 2021. The public has had beneficial use of all Project areas since March 10, 2021. The Project was completed with Final Acceptance granted on March 31, 2021. All Work has been completed in accordance with the Plans and Specifications. No liquidated damages shall be assessed.

Final pay quantities have been computed for the Project and are adjusted to reflect the difference between the preliminary estimated quantities and the final quantities, resulting in a net total Increase of \$29,904.26.

Final payment by the Owner shall not release the Contractor or the Surety(ies) from any obligation under the Contract Documents for the Performance and Payment Bond or release the Contractor from any claims the Owner may have against the Contractor.
