

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES  
ALS FIRST RESPONDER GROWTH MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT**

**THIS AMENDMENT** made this 28 day of August, 2019, between the CITY OF SAFETY HARBOR, a Florida municipal corporation ("Contractor") and the PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, a special district ("Authority").

1. Contractor and the Authority are parties to that certain Emergency Medical Services ALS First Responder Growth Management Agreement, dated May 7, 2019, (the "Agreement") so as to respond to EMS Incidents in accordance with the then current Priority Dispatch Protocols. All capitalized terms used in this Amendment shall have the same meaning as defined in the Agreement, unless otherwise defined herein.
2. The Agreement between the Contractor and the Authority will, pursuant to its terms, expire September 30, 2019, but also contains an option to extend for three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
3. Contractor and Authority wish to extend the Agreement for one (1) additional one (1) year term with a new expiration of September 30, 2020.
4. Contractor and Authority agree that, except as provided herein, all terms of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.






