Description & Comments

Human Services is requesting approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Funding Agreement Renewal with Operation PAR, Inc. (Operation PAR) for adult inpatient detoxification (detox) treatment.

This Renewal continues funding for adult inpatient detox, which provides medically monitored substance detox along with counseling, case management, and group sessions to stabilize individuals. Operation PAR also connects clients to the Pinellas County Health Program/Health Care for the Homeless Program for primary health care.

This is a (2) two-year Renewal of an agreement that has been in effect since October 1, 2020, and is expiring on September 30, 2023. The new terms are effective October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2025.

County funding for personnel and operating costs helps to maintain the equivalent of roughly two (2) detox beds annually. Operation PAR utilizes evidence-based best practices to provide integrated substance abuse and mental health services to its clients. Operation PAR provided mental health and substance abuse detox treatment services to 410 unduplicated clients in FY22.

Funding in the amount of \$214,987.50 is consistent with the FY24 Proposed Budget.
