Description & Comments

This item is for the annual renewal of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) for twenty five (25) different Advanced Life support provider agencies. The providers consist of fourteen (14) local municipalities, four (4) fire districts, four (4) helicopter ambulance companies, two (2) hospitals, and one (1) ambulance service provider. Their current certificates expire on December 31, 2021 and if approved, they will be renewed for a one (1) year term ending December 31, 2022. These certificates allow the provider agencies to be licensed by the Florida Department of Health and the certification process ensures a coordinated and regulated Emergency Medical Service system at a County level. Certificates are issued on an annual basis.

This COPCN renewal process does not carry a fee and has no fiscal impact for the department.
