To Our Pinellas County Commissioners:

We, the citizens of Pinellas County, plus Visitors to Pinellas County from Near and Far, and the Many Golfers that recreate here, present these **19,188 names** on our signed petition to show the resolve of many that there be **No REZONING** allowed to the Tides Golf Course located at 11832 66TH Avenue North, Seminole, Florida. We want it to be maintained as Recreational Open Space, so we and our future generations may enjoy its wondrous beauty.

Homeowners living on the Tides golf course and the more than 3000 residences that surround it recognize the Tides Golf Course as a Recreational Green Open Space that generates opportunities for untold hours of enjoyment, recreating and relaxing playing the game of golf.

A number of years ago, the significance of the Tides as a watershed was realized. Water was backing up and flooding. It was rerouted to the Tides which allows the water to flow over the golf course, clean its contents, absorb it into the earth and eventually reach our Aquifer. Our flood issue was alleviated. With the issue of water shortages and storm water runoff, this must be a major concern for our Commissioners.

Access to the area is now critical. There is one major roadway-66TH Avenue North for the people of this area. The other roads feed around the neighborhood or into the neighborhood. This is an Emergency issue plus an evacuation issue now, plus you're adding maybe 350 more households. That cannot make sense since the 66TH Avenue corridor cannot be widened according to some County Officials.

Thousands of people travel to our County, spending their money, to enjoy our beaches, eat at our restaurants and play in particular the Tides Golf Course. These 150 acres of pristine beauty and precious open space can never be re-created once it is destroyed! It is "Joined at the Hip", so to speak, with our beautiful New Millennium Park~both acting as a natural preserve for our environment and animals that nest and prosper here. There are majestic Eagles, endangered Wood Storks, owls, egrets, hawks, Ospreys and Rosetta Spoonbills that inhabit this area. Many even nest here. Plus we

have Brazilian otters, large turtles of all types, raccoons, armadillos, Coyotes that rely on this Golf Course for their very survival. Plus the occasional alligator finds his home in the course's spacious lakes.

Do Not Let the Greed of a few take a wonderland for animal and man alike and destroy it! Please take the road that our Pinellas County Commissioners more than 25 Years ago took, making this a **Recreational Open Space** for our County. We want our Pinellas County of Commissions to Vote – **NO to the REZONING**, and a destruction of this beautiful Natural Resource called the Tides Golf Course!
