<p>Approval of the ranking of firms and agreement with the number one ranked firm Ignyte Group, Inc. as needed by the Business Technology Services Department (BTS) and Human Services (HS).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Funding for this action is included in the current-year budget of Business Technology Services in the ARAP Fund project 006003A. • This contract will provide a modern integration and data management platform solution with a modern, data-driven Human Services/Social Services Case Management system. • The contract has a term of ten (10) years with a not-to-exceed value of \$11,384,141.10; the agreement contains provisions for three (3), additional thirty-six (36) months terms. • BTS is estimating that \$4,065,010 of the \$5.7M available in ARPA project 006003A will be utilized on this contract for the Human Services Software System Modernization. This will allow for the initial setup and system costs over the next five years. • Starting in FY30, the funding for this project will need to come from either the BCC Strategic Projects, or the Human Services budget.
