## **Description & Comments**

This is a resolution adopting countywide minimum standards for radio frequency testing in new and existing high-rise structures; and providing for effective dates. Existing high-rise buildings are not required to comply with this minimum radio signal strength for fire department communications until January 1, 2025. However, by January 1, 2024, an existing high-rise building that is not in compliance, must apply for an appropriate permit for the required installation of a two-way radio communication enhancement system with the local government agency having jurisdiction and must demonstrate that the building will become compliant by January 1, 2025. This standard will provide for consistent enforcement across all jurisdictions and provide guidance for requiring signal enhancements when needed as it pertains to the Pinellas County Radio System.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this resolution to the County.
