OMB has no objection to *Public Works* submitting a grant application to the U.S. **Environmental Protection Agency** for the **Air Pollution Control, Section 105** grant which will benefit the County by focuses on the core air protection objectives of attaining and maintaining National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), ambient monitoring, addressing air toxics, supporting compliance and enforcement efforts, and permitting air pollution sources through assisting in the planning, developing, establishing, improving and maintaining adequate programs for prevention and control of air pollution.
