The Human Services Department requests approval of this Memorandum of Understanding under the County Administrator's delegated authority. Provision of service by the Court is supported by the recently awarded Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) Elevate Grant, which is a follow-up to the previous "You Can" program. The purpose of the Elevate grant is to reduce crime and substance abuse among high risk/high need, non-violent offenders aged 18-30 who have been diagnosed with a substance abuse disorder, have experienced trauma, and may also be struggling with a mild co-occurring mental health disorder.

The County Administrator approved acceptance of the BJA grant award on October 26, 2015. BJA awarded the full 3-year budget of \$299,491 (Legistar item # 15-356). A Budget Resolution will follow to recognize the new receipts and appropriate the expenditure budget accordingly. The Court portion of the FY16 budget will be \$53,300, mostly in salary and benefits. FY17 and FY18 budget submissions will include allocations for years 2 and 3. The MOU is retroactive to September 30, 2015 and effective through September 29, 2018.
