The Human Services Department requests approval and execution by the County Administrator of the award acceptance and funding agreements with four (4) nonprofit entities for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant-Countywide (JAGC).

Funding in an amount not to exceed \$268,112.00 is provided by JAG-C to support seven projects in Pinellas County. Of these projects, five projects totaling \$141,811.00 will be administered by Human Services. The Pinellas County Sheriff and the St. Petersburg Police Department will administer each of their own respective projects directly with FDLE. These two projects have a combined total of \$126,301.00.

The funding agreements for approval include: Alpha House for a Child Abuse Prevention program (\$25,000.00), MORE Health for Firearm Safety & Violence Prevention training for youth (\$25,000.00), Suncoast Center's Forensic Focused Outreach for case management and treatment (\$35,000.00), and WestCare Mustard Seed Inn Case Management (\$30,000.00).

All four (4) agreements are effective for a period of one (1) year, from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. Requests for reimbursement will be made on a monthly basis within 15 days of the end of the month.

Appropriation to support related grant activities is consistent with the development of the FY21 adopted budget.
