Ordinance amending Section 118-32 of the Pinellas County Code relating to the Tourist Development Plan to temporarily increase funding for Elite Events (marketing special events and programs) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027.			
The proposed ordinance authorizes a one-time increase of \$367,500 in the maximum allocation available for the Elite Events Funding Program, increasing the annual cap from \$3,000,000 to \$3,367,500 for FY2027 only. Beginning in FY2028, the funding cap automatically reverts to the existing \$3,000,000 limit.			
Adoption of the ordinance does not, by itself, create an immediate fiscal impact or appropriation. Rather, it provides authority for up to an additional \$367,500 in existing TDT revenues to be awarded through the FY2027 Elite Events Program, subject to future budget and funding decisions.			
The amendment allows all eligible FY2027 Elite Event applications recommended by the Tourist Development Council to be funded at their eligible levels. If the Board of County Commissioners chooses to do so, the FY27 Proposed Budget will be adjusted accordingly.
