

FOURTH AMENDMENT

This Amendment is made and entered into this 29 day of September, 2024, by and between Pinellas County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County," and Econolite Systems, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Contractor," (individually referred to as "Party", collectively "Parties").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor entered into an agreement on October 20, 2020, pursuant to Pinellas County Contract No. 189-0215-P (hereinafter "Agreement") pursuant to which the Contractor agreed to provide Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS), implementation and maintenance for the County; and

WHEREAS, Section twenty-one (21) of the Agreement permits modification by mutual written agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor now wish to modify the Agreement in order to provide for additional funds and a term extension, at the same prices, terms, and conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. The Parties agree to extend the term of the Agreement an additional year from July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025, for maintenance and support services.
2. Section five (5) ("Compensation and Method of Payment"), subsection A, is revised to reflect an increase in the amount of \$51,300.00 to the total agreed upon total of \$1,819,983.42, for a new total not-to-exceed expenditure of \$1,871,283.42.
3. Except as changed or modified herein, all provisions and conditions of the original Agreement and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

Each Party to this Amendment represents and warrants that: (i) it has the full right and authority and has obtained all necessary approvals to enter into this Amendment; (ii) each person executing this Amendment on behalf of the Party is authorized to do so; (iii) this Amendment constitutes a valid and legally binding obligation of the Party, enforceable in accordance with its terms.
