Attached are the current Pinellas County EMS ambulance rates legislatively set by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners that are updated periodically; however, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement executed between LogistiCare Solutions LLC, and Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services DBA Sunstar EMS, effective on September 25, 2018, Sunstar EMS will be reimbursed in accordance with this executed fee schedule. Should CMS revise their fee schedule, this document will be revised in accordance with the new CMS fee schedule and the associated effective date of those revisions.

Provider must perform transportation at the class of service (e.g., ambulatory sedan/van, wheelchair, stretcher, or non-emergency ambulance) requested by LGTC.

LGTC pays properly submitted uncontested invoices twice per month by check or electronic transfer within thirty days after submission. If a payment date falls on a weekend or holiday, payments will be made on the next working weekday.
