**Description & Comments**

This is an intent to apply for the Water Quality Improvement Grant program through the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP).

If awarded, this grant will benefit the County by eliminating the continued risk of groundwater contamination of wastewater through aging on-site septic systems, as well as eliminate the potential risk of wastewater leaching via groundwater into an environmentally sensitive portion of upper Old Tampa Bay through converting four (4) on-site septic treatment systems by constructing a new wastewater collection system consisting of approximately 3400 linear feet of force main, and four wastewater pumping stations at shelters #2, #3, #5, #8, and the rehabilitation of existing pump station 614 in Philippe Park, allowing for the system to connect to the City of Safety Harbor's wastewater collection system for proper treatment and disposal.

This grant will be single-year and single-departmental, which will likely impact Fiscal Year 2025, cross over into Fiscal Year 2026, and Parks and Conservation Resources has already coordinated with FDEP.

This grant will be administered by Parks and Conservation Resources in close coordination with FDEP.

The total application amount is \$2,450,000.00 with \$1,000,000.00 match required, from the Penny for Pinellas Fund. There are no other funding sources associated with this project, which will complete the total project budget of \$3,450,000.00.

This is not budgeted and would likely require a future budget amendment.

Based on the thresholds for delegated approval, this grant application will require Board approval to apply.
