Dear Commissioner Scott,

I am a Pinellas County resident writing on behalf of Best Friends Animal Society to offer our support of the proposed amendments to Pinellas County's animal ordinances.

Best Friends is a leading animal welfare organization dedicated to saving the lives of dogs and cats in America's shelters and making the entire country no-kill. Founded in 1984, Best Friends runs lifesaving facilities and programs nationwide in partnership with more than 5,500 shelters and rescue organizations, including many in Florida.

In particular, three of the proposed amendments provide important clarifications and protections to improve the health and safety of animals in Pinellas County, while putting in place valuable protections for consumers.

First, the amendments remove barriers for the public to help in managing and caring for community cats — defining the terms “feral cat colony caretaker” and “colony caregiver” in ways that protect and support the lifesaving activities encompassed in these roles. Additionally, by specifying that a “private animal nonprofit organization” is an organization that does TNVR, the cats of Pinellas County, and the people who care for and love them, will be better served.

Second, the proposed amendments found in Article II, Division I, Section 14-29 are commonsense additions to the code for improving the health and welfare of puppies sold in pet stores and for increasing consumer transparency. This section also improves definitions and parameters for how animals are housed, which is another positive advancement — especially with the updated housing standards

including hobby breeders. These improvements will keep puppies healthier, benefiting the pets and people in Pinellas County.

Finally, we support the proposed amendment to the hold times for pets during a disaster. The update creates a balance between the ability of pet owners to find and reclaim animals, while recognizing that shelters must be able to create positive outcomes for the pets in their care. These changes make positive outcomes for pets in shelters more likely by allowing pets to be adopted into homes or transferred into rescue groups, opening space for other cats and dogs in need.

We deeply appreciate all your work to improve the welfare of pets in Pinellas County. Please let me know if we can provide any assistance.

I urge you to vote YES on the proposed revisions to the Retail Pet Sale Ordinance (14-29) this Tuesday, December 16, 2025, at 6:00 PM.

The current standards are clearly not enough.

Evidence as to why these standards are needed:

- **400+ Total Citations** have been issued to Pinellas retail pet stores, this year alone (per Jay McGill, PCAS Enforcement Manager). **Every single pet store received citations.**

The Pet Dealer Permit for Blue Sky Puppies was recently REVOKED by PCAS due to severe, ongoing violations:

- - Concealed Deaths: Blue Sky Puppies turned in dozens of deceased puppies for cremation over two years, failing to notify PCAS as required.

The following information is available to you upon request for all dogs available for adoption in this area. City of Largo Code of Ordinances Chapter 2, Section 72.

- Current health certificate for the pet
- The name and USDA license number of the breeding facility
- The only state and city license of the breeder of origin
- Three years of USDA inspection reports on the breeder of origin

All City of Largo pet shops must not sell dogs or cats that are from a USDA Licensed breeder. All breeders must have an active sales license in good standing with the state which has active sales licenses must not have any other violations and no more than three indirect violations received by the USDA in the last three years. Three violations should be noted on the inspection reports available for your review prior to purchasing a pet.



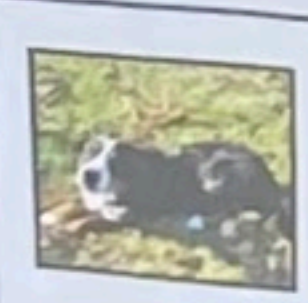

Puppy with microchip number 990000011915510 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 06-06-2024. However, Florida OCVI was signed by vet on 06-13-2024 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale. This OCVI was signed by the veterinarian 5 days after the puppy was supposedly deceased.

Puppy with microchip number 900263000871491 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 02-23-2025. However, Florida OCVI was signed by vet on 03-14-2025 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale. This OCVI was signed by the veterinarian 19 days after the puppy was supposedly deceased.

Puppy with microchip number 99000008064227 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 07-25-2023. Blue Sky is unable to provide any treatment logs or any vet records as to how, why or when this puppy died. This puppy had a OCVI signoff on by a veterinarian on 07-13-2023 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale.

Puppy with microchip number 990000009921772 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 07-25-2023. Blue Sky is unable to provide any treatment logs or any vet records as to how, why or when this puppy died. This puppy had a OCVI signoff on by a veterinarian on 07-20-2023 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale.

Puppy with microchip number 990000008088302 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 07-27-2023. Blue Sky is unable to provide any treatment logs or any vet records as to how, why or when this puppy died. This puppy had a OCVI signoff on by a veterinarian on 07-20-2023 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale.

Puppy with microchip number 99000006895201 was brought to Sun-Surf Animal Hospital for cremation on 08-12-2023. Blue Sky is unable to provide any treatment logs or any vet records as to how, why or when this puppy died. This puppy had a OCVI signoff on by a veterinarian on 08-10-2023 advising that the puppy was in good health and ready for sale.

- Veterinary Farce (photo below): Certificates of Inspection were signed by vets declaring puppies ready for adoption—**even after those puppies had already died and been euthanized.**
- Hundreds more citations on record, including unsanitary and overcrowded conditions, unlicensed staff performing veterinary tasks, the store manager admitted that staff without veterinary degrees were diagnosing and treating the puppies, etc.

Sunshine Puppies, amassed 98 total citations (as of October) for appalling conditions, (all photos attached are Sunshine except the one in red talking about approving health certificates for dogs that have already been euthanized), including:

- Failure to provide adequate kennel space.
- Failure to isolate sick puppies.
- Diarrhea documented in kennels.
- Failure to keep pet food in rodent-free containers, and storing it near buckets of what appeared to be feces
- Rusty cages

Why We Must Adopt the Proposed Standards

The proposed revisions are necessary to close loopholes and improve accountability:

- Increase formal, unannounced permit compliance inspections to twice annually.
- Require solid flooring in all kennels for improved welfare.
- Mandate electronic submission of Point of Sale (POS) forms, requiring certification that the breeder has NO significant USDA violations in the last three years.
- Implement a \$500 fine and immediate 7-day suspension for animal welfare violations.

We must prioritize protecting our citizens and animal welfare over profit. Please ensure the strongest possible ordinance is adopted and strictly enforced.

Finally, I want to express my sincere thanks to Director Renner and her staff for their professionalism, diligence in enforcing the law, and for the countless hours spent organizing the citations, photographs, and evidence that brought these issues to light.
