<p>This is an intent to apply for the Criminal Justice, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse Reinvestment grant through the State of Florida Department of Children and Families.</p> <p>If awarded, this grant will benefit the County by allowing for planning, implementing, or expanding initiatives that increase public safety, avert increased spending on criminal and juvenile justice systems, and improve the accessibility and effectiveness of treatment services for adults and juveniles who have a mental illness, substance use disorder, or co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders, and who are in, or at risk of entering, the criminal or juvenile justice systems, through a recommendation from the Public Safety Coordinating Council that may or may not include the County alone.</p> <p>This grant will be multi-year and single-departmental, which will likely impact Fiscal Year 2024. Pinellas County Human Services has already coordinated with the State of Florida Department of Children and Families.</p> <p>This grant will be administered by Pinellas County Human Services in close coordination with the State of Florida Department of Children and Families.</p> <p>The total application amount is \$1,200,000.00 with \$0.00 match required. There are no other funding sources associated with this project at this time, which will complete the total project budget of \$1,200,000.00</p> <p>This is not budgeted and would likely require a future budget amendment.</p> <p>Based on the thresholds for delegated approval, this grant application will require Director approval to apply.</p>
