Subject: **Gulf Beach Water Booster Station – Scope of Services within FDOT Right of Way**

Revisions have been italicized and underlined for clarity.

The purpose of this document is to describe the extent of work for the Gulf Beach Water Booster Station project within the Gulf Boulevard FDOT Right of Way to support the execution of a construction agreement and the granting of FDOT Drainage Connection Permit 24-D-799-00005.

The scope of services within the FDOT Right of Way and references to where this work can be found on the drawings associated with the previously mentioned permit are as follows:

- Demolition of existing concrete sidewalk (Sheet C-5);
- Removal of vegetation (Sheet C-5);
- Removal of underground electric service line (Sheet C-5);
- Construction of concrete sidewalk (Sheet C-6);
- Fill slope to tie proposed grading into existing grade between back of sidewalk and the right of way line (Sheet C-7 and C-12);
- Temporary Construction Fencing (Sheet C-10);
- Erosion control such as silt fence (Sheet C-19);
- Sodding and/or seeding (Sheet C-12);
- Pedestrian bench, waste receptacle, and pedestrian scale lighting (Sheet L-1);
- Miscellaneous activities as needed to support construction of the Gulf Beach Water Booster Station.
- Removal and replacement of water main (Sheet C-8)
