### Description & Comments

This is for approval and execution by the Public Works Director of the grant application with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the surveys, studies, research, investigations, demonstrations, and special purpose activities relating to the Clean Air Act; Section 103 Grant, Fine Particulate Matter (PM 2.5) Ambient Monitoring Network. Grant application requests \$189,158.00 in support of the County's existing Fine Particulate Matter (PM 2.5) Ambient Monitoring Network. No match is required. The grant is on a reimbursement basis.

The \$189,158.00 funding is consistent and included in the FY25 adopted budget included in the Public Works' Environmental Management Division's Air Quality operating budgets. Grant reimbursement revenues and associated expenditures are included in the FY25 adopted budget. A budget amendment may be required for FY26 and FY27. Reimbursement is anticipated in FY25 (\$47,290.00), FY26 (\$94,579.00) and FY27 (\$47,289.00).
