Description & Comments

This is to adopt an Ordinance revoking Ordinance No. 2020-31 which granted Jabil, Inc. a Phase I Ad Valorem Tax Exemption (ADVTE). Pursuant to Resolution 2018-15, Jabil, Inc. established a three-phase Ad Valorem Tax Exemption program. The Phase I and Phase II ordinances are currently in effect, while Phase III has not been initiated. In December 2025, Jabil Inc. formally requested that the County revoke the Phase I ordinance, citing changes in its business model at the applicable location.

On October 20, 2020, the Board adopted Ordinance 2020-31 approving Jabil, Inc.'s Phase I application to Pinellas County requesting an ad valorem tax exemption for 100% of the assessed value of the qualifying improvements to real property and qualifying tangible personal property specified in its application. Jabil, Inc. no longer wishes to participate in the Phase I Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program.

Payment of the ad valorem taxes exempted during the period of noncompliance will be required, with the final amount to be determined by the Property Appraiser's Office, which is not currently included in this report.

Funding for the ad valorem taxes payment is not included in the FY26 budget for the General Fund.
