Justification Narrative

We believe this application should be granted because it is consistent with Pinellas County's Strategic Plan, specifically helping foster continual economic growth and vitality as well as ensuring the public's health safety and welfare. Lealman Trail is unique in that it will be taking advantage of the affordable housing density bonus, allowing housing for lower income families. Affordable housing remains a critical theme with future development and has been considered in this project. Currently, the subject area is primarily single family residential, multi-family housing, and vacant parcels.

Additionally, future projects in the area will further enhance this development such as the Lealman Form-Based Code (LFBC) and Linking Lealman (LL). The LFBC will allow for this type of development in the Neighborhood Convenience District, in which this project would fall under once effective. Many of the elevated design concepts that will be used are required or encouraged under the LFBC. Linking Lealman is a project aimed at increasing multi-modal forms of transportation in this area and would help encourage alternative transportation methods with a network of interconnected trails and pathways.

This project does not fall in a Flood Zone or Hurricane Evacuation Zone and therefore is not subject to those concerns.
