She said the group waved signs to show support for presidential candidate Joe Biden and raise excitement for the election," the outlet reported. "We're not here to create anything but other than sign-waving," Wentz said. "It was the whole reason why I got involved. It was peaceful." "But at their last event before Election Day, things turned violent as a group of Trump supporters arrived in their usual spot before they did. The violence though didn't come from a clash between Trump supporters and Biden Supporters. Wentz said the violence came from the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. From the men she'd hoped were there to protect her." "I was like, things get crazy. The police are gonna be there, and they're gonna help. I didn't expect that," she said.
