This change order is for additional work related to the security access control system resulting in additional time, materials, and labor.

REASON FOR CHANGE:

This change order will provide additional capability to the security access control system for a user to place a door in a "hold open" position. Normally, an entryway that is left open beyond a defined duration will signal an alarm and notify the command center that a secured entryway has be left open and no longer secure. The addition of this "hold open" capability will allow for airlines to leave the doors open from the hold room to the apron to allow boarding and deboarding of passengers to and from the aircraft.

In order to complete the work associated with this change order, there is a one hundred forty-eight (148) consecutive calendar day time extension associated with this change order. The revised Agreement term expiration date is October 25, 2019.
