Approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Subaward Specific Performance and Land Use Restriction Agreement with WestCare GulfCoast - Florida, Inc. (WestCare), for CDBG funded facility improvements.

This Agreement provides CDBG funding, not to exceed \$28,424.00, for costs associated facility improvements including the installation of a new HVAC unit and installing exterior security lights and camera systems at WestCare's Mustard Seed Inn, benefitting approximately 70 homeless adults recovering from alcohol, drug abuse and/or mental illness. The Agreement is effective for one year, from October 1, 2023, to September 30, 2024. Use of the property is restricted to serving as transitional housing for homeless adults recovering from alcohol, drug abuse and/or mental illness through October 1, 2029.

The County received \$2,475,188.00 in CDBG funding for FY24. Funding is to be used to improve neighborhoods, provide decent housing, and create new economic opportunities, with a special focus on serving low- and moderate-income persons.

The \$28,424.00 of CDBG funding is consistent and included in the FY24 Adopted Budget for CDBG funds within Housing and Community Development Department.
