Elise possesses a playfulness and curiosity rarely seen and highly treasured by those in education. She enjoys the process of problem-solving and embraces it wholeheartedly. Elise tackles challenges with a positive attitude and open mind, and she surrounds herself with students who approach their studies with similar enthusiasm. Elise uses her tremendous capacity for logic and communication to lead others through complicated tasks.

If Elise's remarkable aspects were limited to the classroom I would still recommend her for selection for the Pinellas County Youth Advisory Committee, but of course they are not.
