

RESOLUTION NO. 20-82

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE;
RESOLUTION 14-19, MAKING CHANGES TO MEMBERSHIP TERMS
OF APPOINTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Board most recently made changes to the membership of the Youth Advisory Committee in 2014; and

WHEREAS, The Board now wishes to amend the appointment term for the Youth Advisory Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County that Section 1(b) of Resolution 11-78, as amended by Resolution 14-94, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

(b) Membership. The Committee shall be open to up to fifteen (15) members in grades 9-12. Students interested in serving on the Committee should submit an application to the County. The Board of County Commissioners will appoint members to serve terms that begin on the date of appointment and are effective until the following year's appointments are made to the Committee. Preference will be given to applicants who have previously participated in the Committee, Committee events, or other County functions. The members of the Committee are encouraged to include additional students in educational and community service activities.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.

In a regular meeting duly assembled on the 10 day of September, 2020, Commissioner Peters offered the foregoing resolution and moved its adoption, which was seconded by Commissioner Long, and upon roll call the vote was:
