Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

A one-year extension of the Airline Operating and Use Agreement with Allegiant Air, LLC granting the airline privileges for use of terminal space and use of the airfield. In exchange for these uses, Allegiant Air, LLC pays user fees to the Airport as defined in the agreement.

Revenue from this agreement is receipted to the Airport Revenue and Operating Fund, included in the FY25 Amended Budget and the FY26 Proposed Budget, in the amount of \$2,571,510.00. Actual revenue in FY24 was \$2,936,301.87.

During FY26 budget development, Airport staff recommended increases to user fees in anticipation of negotiations for a new five-year agreement. Based on long-range fiscal forecasts and in consultation with the Office of Management and Budget, and County Administration, the Airport determined that the user fee increases should be revisited. To allow adequate time to revisit the user fees, a one-year extension to the current agreement is being recommended to the Board. A new five-year agreement is planned for FY27-FY31.
