SUBJECT: United States Environmental Protection Agency Section 105 Air Pollution Control Grant

DATE: July 1, 2021

The Environmental Management Division of Public Works is recommending the approval of the grant application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency. This grant application will provide additional funding to support the existing air pollution control program.

Public Works is seeking grant funding in the amount of \$537,300.00 over a two-year project period (FY22 - \$250,000.00; FY23 - \$287,300.00). A match is required and estimated at \$1,924,920.00 over the two-year project period (FY22 - \$959,920.00; FY23 - \$ 965,000.00). The grant is on a reimbursement basis. The source of the estimated total project costs of \$2,462,220.00 is the Environmental Management Division's Air Quality operating budgets for FY 22 and FY23.

Authority for the Director of Public Works to sign this grant application is granted under the County Administrator's delegation of authority dated March 28, 2016.
