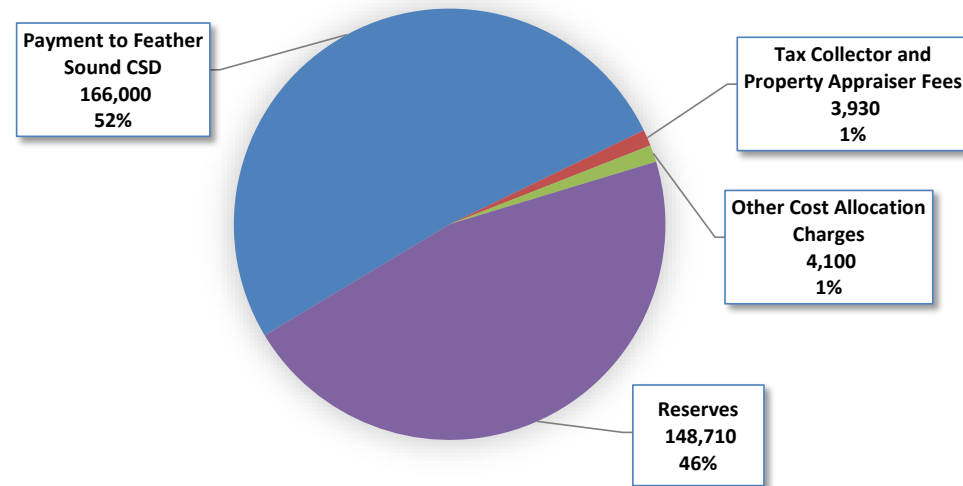


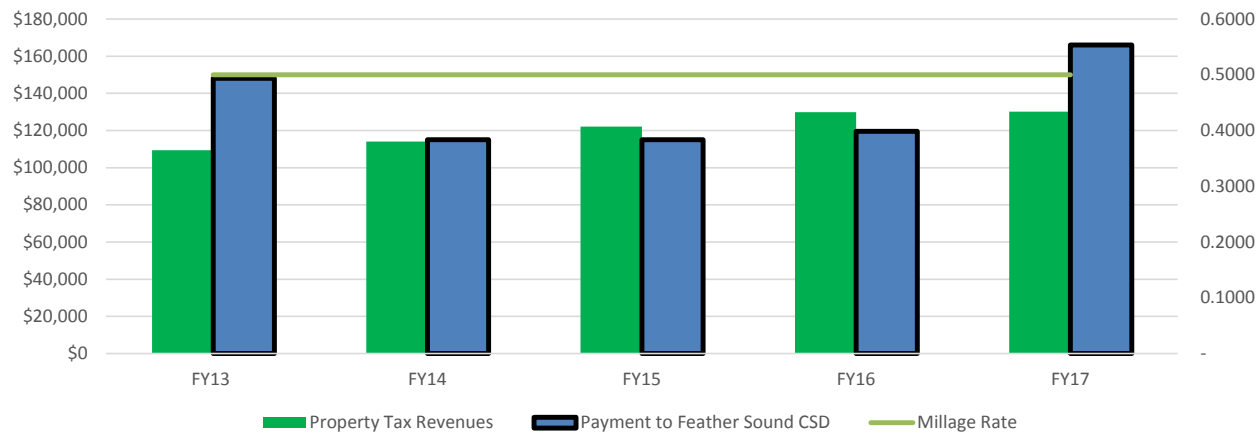

Feather Sound CSD Budget History



The Feather Sound Community Services District is supported by a dedicated property tax levy, currently at 0.5 mills. The District is a non-profit entity which provides street lighting and parkland maintenance services for the area. The amount paid to the non-profit is less than their actual operating budget (\$216,340), because the non-profit has excess reserve funds (\$140,950) that are being drawn down over a multi-year period. The FY17 budget request includes funds for the design and planning costs associated with updating the community entrance way signage.

FEATHER SOUND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

The Feather Sound Community Services District (FSCSD) is a special taxing district within unincorporated Pinellas County. This special taxing district was created by a vote of the residents of Feather Sound. It was established for the purpose of providing street lighting and the acquisition, development and maintenance of recreational areas and green space for the residents of Feather Sound. The services are funded by ad valorem taxes. Property owners within the district are levied a separate millage for this purpose. The maximum millage rate that can be levied is 1.0 mill.
