Federal Storm Damage Reduction Projects




Overview


- 35 miles of beach
- 21.4 miles critically eroded
- 12 miles are restored regularly
- Initial authorization 1966
- Storm damage reduction benefits: >\$10B








Federal Storm Damage Reduction Projects



- Pre-2018 nourishment cycles have been completed using both permanent and temporary easements
- Nov. 2017 USACE notified the County of the policy change
- 2018 nourishment proceeded with some areas skipped due to lack of easements
- Since 2017, easement acquisition has been a priority to ensure both periodic and storm damage restoration projects
- 2024 Sand Key project is on hold indefinitely; 2023 Treasure Island, LK-Upham, Pass-A-Grille recently put on hold until easement status is confirmed






- Estimate costs and revenues under full funding, partial funding and no funding scenarios
- Based on current TDT allocation
- Nourishment cycles
 - 4 years: Current Treasure Island & Long Key-Upham
 - 6 years: Sand Key & the new authorization for Treasure Island & Long Key-Upham
 - 8 years*: Sand Key nourishment + structures
 - ~10 years: Pass-A-Grille






- Do not include costs for rehabilitation or reconstruction of existing structures or mitigation and other associated costs
- Do not include interim nourishments that may be needed as a result of storm damage
 - USACE advised of ineligibility for Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies (FCCE) Appropriations without 100% easements
 - County funded storm damage restoration activities are ineligible for FEMA reimbursement















Revenues

Expenditures


Fund Balance

Financial Overview Summary



- FO1 (Full cost share all segments) Sufficient revenue to support nourishment projects & other coastal management needs.
- FO2 (Full cost share TI, LK, PAG & County funds SK) Fund is balanced through FY32. TI, LK, PAG funded; insufficient funds for future SK nourishments.
- FO3 (FO2+ structures) Fund is balanced through FY32. TI, LK, PAG funded through FY38; insufficient funds for nourishments beyond FY40.
- FO4 (Full cost share TI, LK, PAG, 40% cost share SK) Fund is balanced and has revenue to support other coastal management needs.
- FO5 (100% County funded) ~\$7M deficit by FY27. Fund does not recover.
