Re: Temporary Closure of Skyway Bridge Application

Dear Mr. Judge:

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners has considered your request for a letter of non-opposition for the SUNSKY 10K on Sunday, March 21, 2027. On June 16, 2026 the Board voted to provide a letter of non-opposition to the Florida Department of Transportation upon satisfaction of the following conditions:

- FRESHJUNKIE Productions, LLC and Run Gulf Coast Foundation add Pinellas County, a Political Subdivision of the State of Florida; the Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services Authority; and the Pinellas County Sheriff, be endorsed as Additional Insureds for the General Liability policy covering the race, but in no event may the insurance be less than that on the attached Exhibit A, or that provided to any other state agency or local governmental entity. Additionally, the insurance must be primary and non-contributory, and the certificate of insurance must be sent to Pinellas County Risk Management, 400 South Fort Harrison Ave., Clearwater, FL 33756.
- The aforementioned insurance coverage must contain a specific participant liability endorsement; alternatively, the participant waiver/release should include a release of liability for Pinellas County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida.
- Additionally, FRESHJUNKIE Productions, LLC and Run Gulf Coast Foundation must agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Pinellas County for all claims and lawsuits arising from the operation of, or participation in, the SUNSKY 10K. These agreements must also be provided to Pinellas County Risk Management. Pinellas County recognizes FRESHJUNKIE Productions, LLC and Run Gulf Coast Foundation likely has a preferred template agreement which may be used if acceptable to Pinellas County Risk Management.
- Copies of all documents sent to Risk Management should be copied to the Pinellas County Attorney, 315 Court St., Clearwater, FL 33756.

Once Pinellas County has received satisfactory proof that these conditions have been met, a letter of non-objection will be provided to the Florida Department of Transportation.

We regret that this request is necessary; however, Pinellas County remains involved in litigation arising from a prior Skyway 10K where insurance was provided for the State and other local governments, but not for the consenting county governments.

We look forward to the return of this popular activity.

EXHIBIT A
INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. General Liability – Race organizers must carry a minimum of general liability coverage in the amounts of \$1,000,000 each Occurrence / \$1,000,000 Aggregate / \$1,000,000 Personal & Adv Injury, for which “Pinellas County, A Political Subdivision of the State of Florida” must be endorsed as Additional Insured.

2. Worker’s Compensation – Race organizers must carry the statutory limit where required by law. If any organizer does not provide Worker’s Compensation coverage, a waiver request form must be completed and submitted. [Work Comp Waiver Form](#)
