I am deeply concerned about the resolution introduced by Commissioner Nowicki, which demands that the library's new strategic plan be "entirely free of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) principles, content, language, or policies."

It has come to my attention that some debate or discussion is occurring about the reading material at the Palm Harbor Library. I am a mom in Pinellas County and I frequently take my child to this library. I have nothing but good things to say about their children's section and the staff who work there.

I respectfully ask that you allow the library to remain as it is and not interfere with its operations.

Please do not remove any material or signage. Please do not limit what the staff can do.

We all value our freedom in this country and that means allowing others the freedom to make the choices they see fit for their family.

I have never seen inappropriate books in the children's section and if I did, I would simply explain to my child that she can read it when she is older.

Censoring discussion around issues such as gender identity or other areas of human diversity is archaic and un-American (freedom of speech and press). It does not protect anyone. Learning about different gender identities does not change a person's gender identity. Cisgendered people will continue to be cisgendered and transgender people will continue to be trans; but removal of these materials perpetuates social taboo and contributes to negative health and mental health outcomes for gender expansive people.

Please focus on actual issues. Thank you.
